Visa requirements	All passport holders must apply for a HK study visa. Students should submit the study visa application form with a copy of passport and financial proof to HKBU International Office. The HKBU International Office will coordinate with the HK Immigration Department in HK on the student's behalf. Students do not need to arrange it at the Chinese embassy / consulate in their home country. The approval process takes 6-8 weeks. Once the visa is approved, the HKBU International Office will collect the visa and send to student's home address by courier service. Students will be required to pay HKBU after arriving HK. Housing:

Accommodation	Exchange students can choose to live on- or off-campus. In order to integrate more fully into the University experience, you are encouraged to live in on- campus dormitories. For students who decide to live in on-campus housing, you will be notified of the application details after you are formally admitted for studies at HKBU. Halls fees are around HK\$6,000~HK\$7,000 per semester. Fees may vary slightly every academic year. Postgraduate exchange students will be housed at the on-campus NTT International House (<u>http://www.hkbuntt.com.hk/ntt_index.php</u>) or off- campus housing depending on availability. At NTT, fees are around HK\$3,000 per month for a double-occupancy room. Fees and rooms
	vary for off-campus housing. The international office will forward PG housing request to the university Housing Office. Upon referral by the Housing Office, the NTT will coordinate with students regarding application and payment procedures.

Insurance:

Health insurance requirements	All exchange and study abroad students are required to obtain adequate insurance prior to arrival in HK. Students should check with their home institutions and/or insurance agents about medical and accident insurance coverage. If the home insurance policy covers the concerned student for his/her overseas study, he/she should retain it. If that is not the case, please remind the student to negotiate for coverage of his/her overseas study in HK (including personal trips outside HK) before travelling.
