At RSM, 20 ECTS is the regular fulltime workload for one trimester; please know that the non- negotiable required minimum workload for exchange students is 15 ECTS per trimester. The maximum number of credits obtained per trimester is 30 ECTS. Students have to obtain the majority of ECTS at RSM.
